

3280 Use of School Facilities

School buildings may be used by outside groups and organizations for educational, social, civic and recreational meetings that are non-exclusive and open to the general public and as a polling place under the provisions of the Election Law. Organizations may charge admission fees only if the proceeds are used for educational or charitable purposes. The Superintendent of Schools shall prepare and maintain rules and procedures for the use of school facilities by members and organizations of the community.

The Board has the final authority to refuse a use requested and in prescribing terms if the use is allowed. This would include the charging of fees to reimburse the School District for expenses incurred. A fee structure will be determined on an annual basis at the organizational meeting.
