Action Steps: Sustainability and Fidelity from 2015-2016

- 1. We will track the academic progress of each individual student and support interventions for success.
- 2. We will continue to develop opportunities for coursework that can occur in a non-traditional setting to create flexible and innovative programming for all students.
- 3. We will monitor standards aligned instruction, K-12, providing support and enriching the current foundation of instructional practice.
- 4. We will support critical thinking, collaboration, communication, and creativity throughout instructional practice.
- 5. We will sustain our development of STEM enrichment and transdisciplinary learning opportunities.
- 6. We will support the use of data throughout the District to drive academic and professional growth.
- 7. We will support our school based mental health and behavior support programs.
- 8. We will articulate Pathways to College coursework in math and English, so all students can receive college credit and avoid remediation in post-secondary study.

Action Steps: 2016-2017

- 1. We will continue to review the scope, sequence and alignment of the K-8 Science program.
- 2. Upon SED adoption, we will begin the transition to the new K-8 ELA and math standards.
- 3. We will implement the new CDOS pathway for graduation.
- 4. We will develop middle school skills based resources that reflect the new Social Studies Framework.
- 5. We will explore opportunities to offer coursework leading to certifications in the building trades.
- 6. We will review the AIS/RTI plan.
- 7. We will build capacity to add an AP Computer Science course for 2017-2018.
- 8. We will begin the transition to Google Apps for Education.
