

MEDIATION TRAINING AND INCORPORATION

- Initial Training:
 - ❖20 members of our faculty were trained in facilitating mediation sessions this past summer
- Next Steps:
 - ❖ Work with Mediation Matters (Saratoga) on creating uniform process and paperwork
 - One additional day of training this winter and needs assessment



MINDFULNESS PILOT EXPANSION

2015-16

 One 6th grade science class, 25 students: 10 minute mindfulness lesson once per week- plus 3 minute core breathing exercises each morning.

2016-17

- 6th Grade, 294 students and select upper level classes
- Student and teacher surveys midyear to evaluate the program
