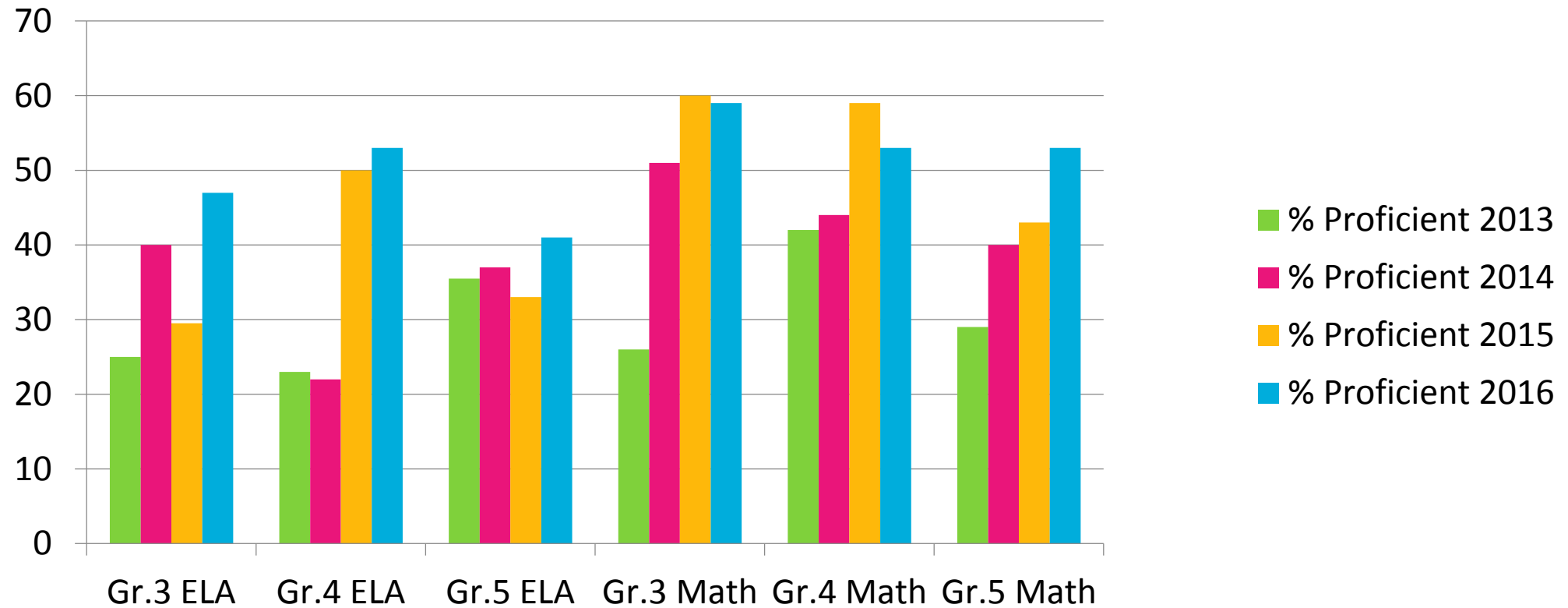

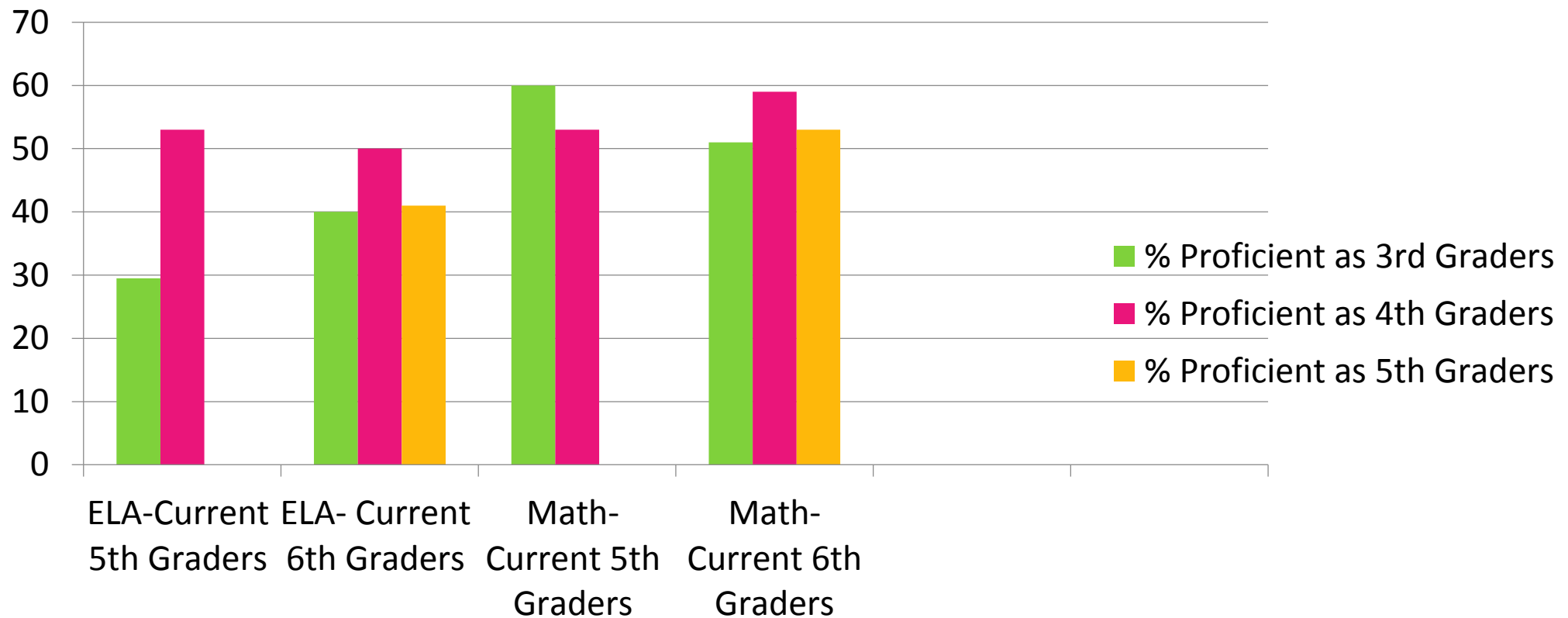

Milton Terrace 2016-17 Academic Community Goals

Shared BLT Academic Goal

- District-wide grade level meetings for continued collaboration

- Common language and prompts

Parent/Teacher Book Studies

- Continued work with “Mindsets in the Classroom” text
- Providing teachers and families with PD on growth mindset language

Milton Terrace 2016-17 Academic Community Goals, continued

Building-wide Reading Goal

- “Read Around The World” Theme
- Goal of every student reading 25 books (11,250 books)
- Passports turned in for collective tallying
- Monthly updates & recognition at school-wide assemblies

Building-wide Math Goal

- Carried over from last year
- “Attack Your Facts” Theme
- Grade level math fact goals
 - Based on *Mastering the Basic Math* Facts by Susan O’Connell
 - Providing PD offered by teachers for teachers
 - Share research tied to texts



Milton Terrace 2016-17 School Community Goals



- Milton Terrace Social Media Presence
 - Continued use of grade level and department Twitter accounts to share academic-related information with parents and the community
- PBIS
 - PBIS/Character Ed committees streamline language for monthly full school assemblies from *Mindsets in the Classroom* summer read text
 - Continue to strengthen PBIS Tier 2 program
 - 24 students check in and out each morning and afternoon with an assigned mentor
 - Monthly team meetings with mentor, team, and parents to review behavioral progress



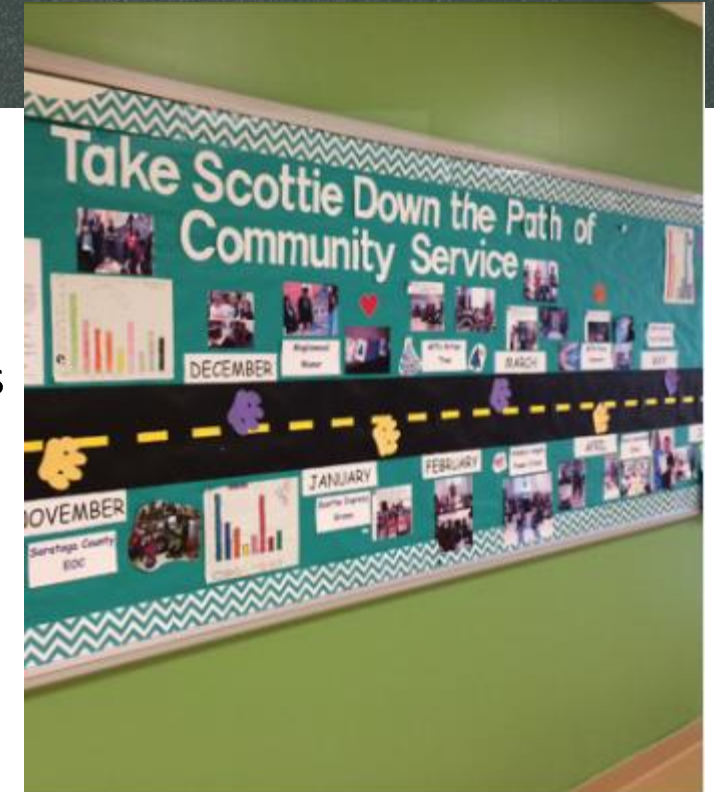
Milton Terrace 2016-17 School Community Goals, continued

- Milton Terrace Pride
 - Celebrate re-designation as a National PTA School of Excellence
 - Increase home-school connections through student birthday cards mailed to each student's home
 - Explore National Blue Ribbon School application process
 - Prepare for and offer musical performance opportunities for all students in grades K-3
 - Kindergarten- TBD
 - 1st Grade- April 28th
 - 2nd Grade- March 31st
 - 3rd grade- May 26th



Milton Terrace 2016-17 Global Community Goals

- “The Community Service” School
 - Co-grade level service learning projects continued
 - Collaborative, focused service learning projects for shared grades
 - K & 5th Grade- Franklin Community Center
 - 1st and 3rd grade- Alex’s Lemonade Stand/ EOC Food Drives
 - 2nd and 4th Grade- Little Libraries
 - Continued school-wide projects and staff projects
- Parsons School-Based Mental Health Clinic
 - Proud host school for 4th year of district-wide initiative supporting students and families
