- College/University: (i.e. Merit Based)







Organization is Key

- *Compile* appropriate information (transcript, resume, letters of recommendation, etc.)
- *Understand* the organization that is granting the scholarship
- Write effective and compelling essays triple check edit and look for typos…
- Make sure applications are complete Don't leave blanks.
- Assemble the application in order Neatness counts…
- Copy the application prior to sending
- Adhere to deadlines
