Brian Sirianni presented on the revenue portion of the budget regarding the Governor's State Aid Proposal.

Mr. Sirianni illustrated the proposed foundation aid for Ballston Spa. He discussed the building, transportation and BOCES Aid Cap for the 2019-2020 school year.

Mr. Sirianni explained the district's transportation expenses and the illustrated the increases and the proposed cap.

Mr. Sirianni explained the revenue sources for 2018-2019 along with the Global Foundries PILOT and the assessed value schedule and changes.

Mr. Sirianni discussed the tax rate comparison for each of the towns in the district.

Mr. Sirianni discussed the budget drivers for budget including the retirement system, medical insurance and prescription drug costs, special education in relation to service and transportation and future lost revenue in regards to Global Foundries.

Mr. Sirianni stated the budget presentation would include information on the allowable tax levy limits, expenditure information and available revenue updates. He stated during the second meeting in March there could potentially be figures available.
