CALL TO ORDER

Kevin Schaefer called the Board of Education meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Kevin Schaefer reminded all of the rules for public comment regarding time limits.

Katie Thiminer, 145 Ruhle Rd. Ballston Spa, NY 12020, discussed the meeting she had with the district and the school district attorney. She expressed her concerns regarding classroom curriculum and district policies. She requested a meeting with the Board of Education.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Dragone congratulated the Launching Pad students that participated in the Broadway Stars Acting Workshop. He stated the show was fabulous and a wonderful opportunity for students. He thanked everyone that had worked so hard. He also thanked Joe Shaver for putting everything together.

Dr. Dragone reminded everyone it was still Music in the Schools Month. He shared information regarding the district's musical activities.

Dr. Dragone went on to recognize and congratulate the students involved in the IB Visual Arts pop-Up Solo Art Shows.

Dr. Dragone reminded everyone of the Fourth Annual Health and Wellness Fair. He thanked Janice McPhee, staff members and district partners for their hard work.

Dr. Dragone stated Wednesday, March 23rd was Social media Safety Night and announced that John Kelly would be the speaker. He stated Augie's would be providing a free dinner prior to the presentation, adding that it was important to RSVP so the dinner count would be correct. He thanked all responsible parties for their participation and hard work getting the Social Media Safety Night set.

Dr. Dragone wished the OM and Robotics Teams good luck in their upcoming competitions.

Gordon Creek Student Council

Members of the Student Council highlighted events and the work being done by Student Council at Gordon Creek School.

Dr. Dragone thanked and congratulated the Student Council.

Tony Leva stated the Student Council had a display table and encouraged everyone to stop by.

Student Presentations

Katie Calhoun and her students discussed the trip to Costa Rica.

Dr. Dragone announced the students on the French Exchange would be back on Sunday and would speak at a later meeting.

Budget

Dr. Dragone gave updates on the draft budget. He discussed the State Aid information that had changed or been obtained since the March 2nd meeting.

Dr. Dragone reminded everyone of the district's mission. He stated the mission was important because it was based on the budget principles and guidelines and the budget goals. He stated the framework allowed for clear prioritizations of decisions for budget building.

Dr. Dragone outlined the college opportunities available in the district. He stated there was more opportunities in the BSCSD than in any other area district. Dr. Dragone stated the district offered many different pathways to the future for students.

Dr. Dragone stated the increase in teacher certifications allowed the district to be innovative and advance the work being done in the district. He stated he was proud of the staff and considered them second to none.

Dr. Dragone gave a side by side view of State Aid proposals from the Executive, the Assembly and the Senate and discussed each. Dr. Dragone also discussed each group's position on additional educational items of interest.

Dr. Dragone highlighted and explained the comptroller's state aid analysis report.

Dr. Dragone outlined the aggregate increase in State school aid per pupil (excluding building aid) by type of aid and need/resource capacity for the school years of 2011-2012 vs. 2015-2016.

Dr. Dragone gave an update on the figures for the 2016-2017 draft budget. He reminded everyone the budget is not balanced until final State Aid numbers are received. He stated that as of this evening there was 2.4% increase from the 2015-2016 school year.

Dr. Dragone gave a comparison summary for school years 2015-2016 to 2016-2017 regarding the four parts of the budget. The parts discussed were general support, instruction, transportation and undistributed.

Dr. Dragone explained the reduction in pension and health insurance costs and the new debt service. He discussed the specific costs associated with each of the four parts of the budget.

Dr. Dragone discussed each of the propositions that voters would have in addition to the budget.

Dr. Dragone gave the next steps in the budget process including the dates for the budget adoption, the budget hearing and the budget vote. He also included the budget meeting dates for the public. Dr. Dragone reminded everyone there would be a board meeting on May 19th.

Dr. Dragone reminded everyone the district was in a ten year situation of declining revenue related to Global Foundries.

Mr. Schaefer stated it was wonderful to have Student Council in the elementary schools to give students a chance to try-on leadership. He reiterated that the district offered many pathways for students.

Mr. Leva stated government students had also attended the board meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Nancy Fodera stated the Safety Committee had met and discussed the May emergency drill. Ms. Fodera went on to report that BARC was offering a new business sponsorship program.

Ms. Fodera reported the Facilities Pride Committee had met and reviewed ongoing efforts.

Ms. Fodera reminded everyone BSEF would be hosting the Taste of Ballston on April 11th at the High School. She stated there were still raffle tickets for the trip to Italy for sale. Ms. Fodera stated the BSEF had reviewed the grant applications at the last meeting.

She reminded all that this was PARP month and that there would be a joint PTA meeting for the budget presentation.

Ms. Fodera reported that the PTA had worked with the Health and Wellness Committee on the Cyber Safety Night.
