#### CALL TO ORDER

Kevin Schaefer called the Board of Education meeting to order at 7:02 pm.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

#### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Dragone thanked the Ballston Spa Education Foundation for another excellent Taste of Ballston Event.

Dr. Dragone reported the Odyssey of the Mind teams had competed recently at regionals and teams from the High School and Milton Terrace would be going to State competition this weekend.

He went on to report the district had recently received the Utica National Insurance Group's School Safety Excellence Award for 2017. Dr. Dragone thanked Ed Martin for his continuous hard work.

He also announced the district had been awarded the Best Communities for Music Award by NAMM.

Dr. Dragone stated the Robotics team was hosting the annual Pizza Fun night and silent auction in the cafeteria. He stated the team would be heading to nationals on April 27-29.

Dr. Dragone reported that the State had not yet released State Aid budget information. He stated the recommended budget would be presented later this evening. He reported the tax levy would be 2.9% and the average tax rate increase would be approximately .06%. This results in a \$22 increase for the average home in the district. He stated the information would be available on the website.

#### High School Troupe

Dr. Dragone invited the Troupe up and reminded everyone there would be another production next weekend. He stated this was a phenomenal production.

Students from the Troupe spoke about the show and encouraged everyone to attend the productions. They thanked everyone for their support and hard work. They gave ticket prices and show times. One of the students performed a song from the production.

Kevin Schaefer encouraged the group to keep up the good work.

#### Student Recognition

Dr. Dragone recognized Mr. Sunkes for his achievements and recent award.

Mr. Sunkes, Coach Buckley and Coach Staulters recognized student athletes for their accomplishments and leadership. The athletes, parents, district and fans were thanked for their dedication and hard work.

Coach Staulters also recognized the veterans in the room and thanked them for their service.

Mr. Sunkes thanked everyone for their hard work.

Mr. Sunkes discussed the Safe Sports School award.

Mr. Sunkes recognized Laura Waldinger for her achievement and recent award.

Kevin Schaefer recognized the students and the coaches and athletic directors for their outstanding work. He recognized the inspiration the student athletes create.

# Budget

Dr. Dragone reminded everyone of the district's mission. He referenced the student awards given previously as evidence of hard work and steadfast to excellence and hard work.

Dr. Dragone outlined the 2017-2018 budget goals.

Dr. Dragone discussed the 2017-2018 tax levy limit calculation.

Dr. Dragone discussed the State Aid update. He explained the Assembly and Senate were at odd and this was keeping the State budget from being finalized.

He shared a slide regarding the Globalfoundries depreciation.

Dr. Dragone shared and explained the recommended budget. He stated the tax levy increase was 2.9%. He presented the budget comparison, the budget drivers and each of the budget components, highlighting the budget goals and explained the increased staff recommendations.

Dr. Dragone shared the contingency budget. He stated the required reductions equaled \$1,401,195. He explained the options available if a budget does not get approved by voters.

Dr. Dragone provided the next steps including meeting dates, budget hearings and votes.

Mr. Schaefer asked clarifying questions regarding a contingency budget.

Dr. Dragone explained.

Mr. Schaefer asked about the ramifications regarding the State budget.

Dr. Dragone explained the district's expectations.

Nancy Fodera stated PARP was in downtown Ballston Spa. Ms. Fodera went on to say the Taste of Ballston had made \$6,000. She reminded everyone the Ireland tickets were on sale until May 5<sup>th</sup>.

Mr. Schaefer stated the Policy Committee continues to meet and will wrap up soon.

Mr. Schaefer stated the Finance Committee met to discuss components of Medicaid compliance. He stated Kathy Simkins had done a wonderful job and was retiring.
