Mayor Frank Rossi, Jr. discussed the potential safety enhancements and requested community support to help get the award of the grant. Mayor Rossi referenced the morning's tragic hit and run event. He thanked first responders.

Mayor Rossi stated it was important to work to prevent fatalities around the school. He thanked Supervisor Connelly and everyone involved in discussions and decisions. He thanked the property owners for their cooperation. Mayor Rossi also stated he is happy to collaborate with the community and the school board.
