- 3rd year of high school Science, 1.0 HS credit

- 3rd year of high school math, 1.0 HS credit
- This course is not NCAA approved.
- Students who are looking to obtain an advanced Regents diploma should also take the high school Algebra II course at their home school since there will be topics covered on the Regents exam which are not covered in the college course.

- 3rd year of high school English, 1.0 credit
- Students will take the NYS Regents exam at their **home school**.
- If a student is accelerated and has completed English 11 as a sophomore, they will still take this course, but it may be counted as a different type of credit at the home school. Please contact your home school counselor if this is the case.

P-TECH Reading & Research; Mrs. Lewis; blewis@bscsd.org

- .5 HS Credit
- Prepares students for the rigor of college research and writing



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P-TECH Career Exploration- .5 High School Elective Credit

- 35-40 hour job shadow OR participation the Future Leaders in Planning Program
- Under the grant, students must participate in career exploration/job shadow experience
- Students will complete a 35-40 in their college pathway in the summer prior to their senior year
- Students will create a resume and interview with a business prior to securing the experience.
