

8470 | Homebound Instruction

The Board of Education of the Ballston Spa Central School District adopts the following policy to provide homebound instruction to resident students enrolled in the public schools or non-public schools who qualify for home tutoring due to a long term or significant illness and who are unable to attend school as determined by school personnel. Homebound instruction shall only be provided upon a determination that it is necessary to enable the student to keep up with class work during a period of illness or other circumstances that prevent the student's regular attendance.

The Board of Education designates the Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum, Assessment, and Pupil Services to develop procedures for handling requests for homebound instruction and coordination of those services once approved.
