FERPA

(Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act)

- Prohibits disclosure of information from a student's education records
- HVCC will not discuss a student's account with a parent over the phone or in person unless the student has authorized the college to release the information to that party and that party has the student's FERPA password
- The form must be notarized prior to mailing it to HVCC
- The form should be mailed to the HVCC Registrar's Office

- Students will contact the CAAT center by completing an Accommodation Request
- Students will have an intake meeting
- After intake meeting students will receive an email to forward to their HVCC professors
- Returning students each semester will log in to Accommodate to print their accommodations

Grant Information

- Students must stay in the pathway they chose at the end of sophomore year (some flexibility if the courses already taken also apply to new major chosen)
- Students are not eligible for financial aid while under P-TECH since P-TECH covers cost of textbooks, tuition & fees, parking
- Students have up to 2 years post senior year to complete. Most students finish in the first year.
- P-TECH will only cover the retaking of 1 class and does not cover remediation classes.
- CIS, Cybersecurity, Engineering- students must have a “C” or better in each CISS course in order to move on to the next.
- Students will not apply to HVCC, but will meet with an advisor and transition through our program.
