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#### FERPA

(Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act)

- Prohibits disclosure of information from a student's education records
- •HVCC will not discuss a student's account with a parent over the phone or in person unless the student has authorized the college to release the information to that party and that party has the student's FERPA password
- •The form must be notarized prior to mailing it to HVCC
- •The form should be mailed to the HVCC Registrar's Office

### **Grant Information**

- Students must stay in the pathway they chose at the end of sophomore year (some flexibility if the courses already taken also apply to new major chosen)
- •Students are not eligible for financial aid while under P-TECH since P-TECH covers cost of textbooks, tuition & fees, parking
- •Students have up to 2 years post senior year to complete. Most students finish in the first year.
- •P-TECH will only cover the retaking of 1 class and does not cover remediation classes.
- •CIS, Cybersecurity, Engineering- students must have a "C" or better in each CISS course in order to move on to the next.
- •Students will not apply to HVCC, but will meet with an advisor and transition through our program.

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
