

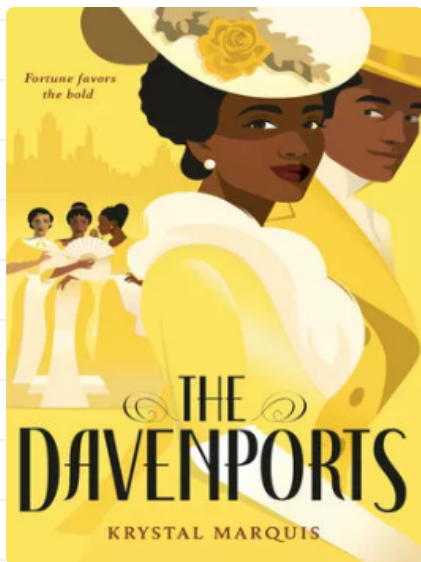

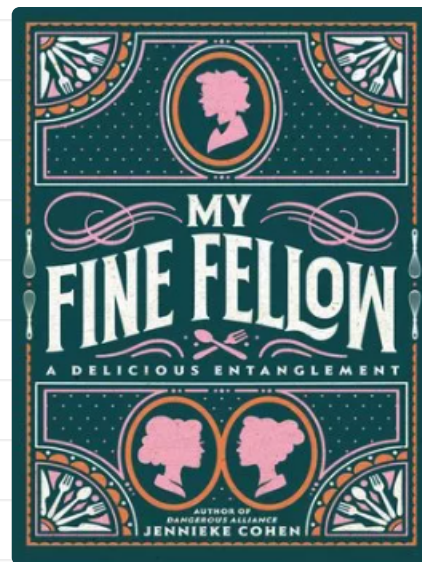
The Davenports by Krystal Marquis

Being hailed as an updated "Breakfast Club," a group of teens take refuge in a bathroom during a party and learn that none of them are

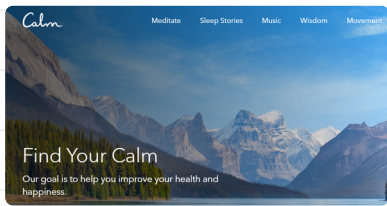


My Fine Fellow by Jennieke Cohen

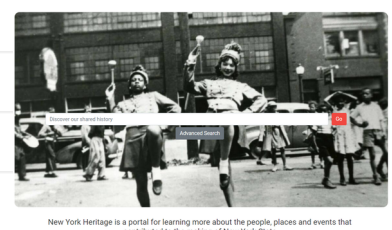
Makerspace for February

Database of the Month

New York Heritage is a database curated by the Empire State Library Network that has primary source material in the form of letters, photographs, diaries, maps, books, directories, and more, from the colonial era to the present, for every region in New York State. Did You Know?

A huge part of working in a library is what we call "feeding and weeding." Feeding is buying new books for the library collection, and weeding is removing books that are dirty, old, outdated, and/or haven't been circulated in a very long time. When we weed books, we are making room for all of the new books, as well as ensuring the library collection is relevant, interesting, and up to date. Whenever a book is weeded, we look at circulation statistics, date of purchase, condition of the book, and consider if we have other books that are similar. This requires going through the stacks and pulling out every single book to decide if it should stay on the shelf or not. The HS library has been overdue for a weeding for quite some time! Some of our classic novels are VERY outdated, old, and gross—see the book example in the picture that has been circulating since the 1960s. You may notice we don't have them in our catalog currently—but have no fear! They have been reordered and we will be getting them back on the shelves as soon as we get them in!



Collaboration Corner

Last month, Ms. Carter's US History class came into the library to do research using databases and online sources on an event or group that contributed to World War II. They then used this research to create a collaborative book using Book Creator! If you want your class to get these lessons, reach out so we can schedule!

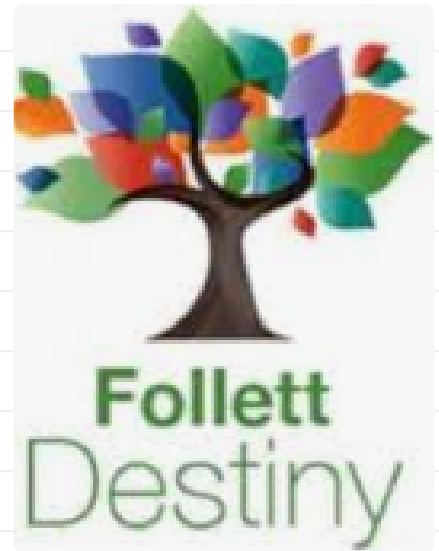
