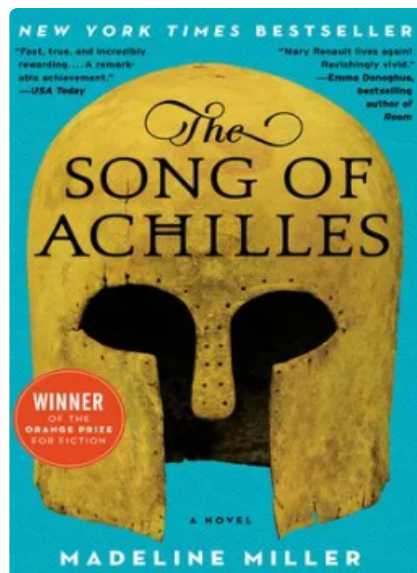

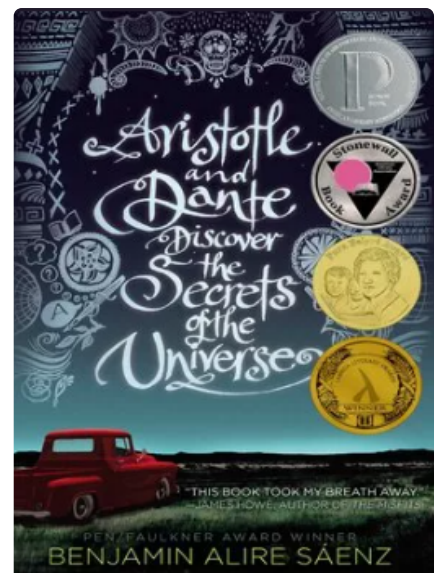
#### The Gilded Ones by Namina Forna

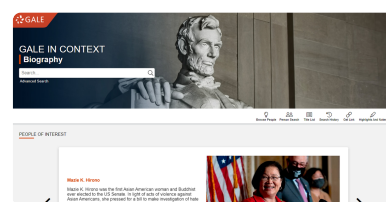
## Makerspace for June

In May, Mrs. Marcotullio's PLTW Human Body Systems classes collaborated with the library to create presentations on a rare disease of their choice. They found images, explored science and

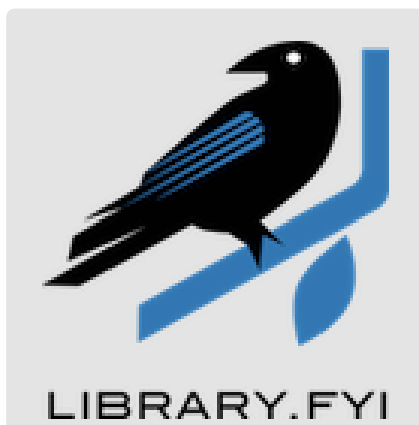
health databases and websites, used NoodleTools to create and export APA citations, and created slideshows that they presented to the class.

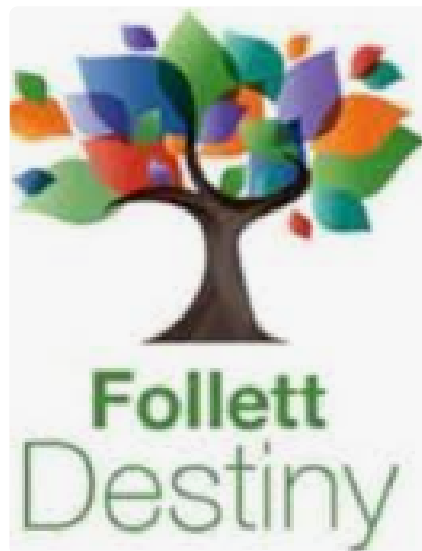
